The GroupWise® 5.5 Enhancement Pack adds new features and functionality to the administration, agent, client, WebAccess, Internet Agent, and Monitor components of GroupWise 5.5.

ENHANCEMENT PACK REQUIREMENTS

- ❑ GroupWise 5.5. The Enhancement Pack must be applied to an existing GroupWise 5.5 system.
- ❑ Individual Enhancement Pack component requirements are included with each component's Quick Start card, accessible through the Enhancement Pack Installation program.

COMPONENT OVERVIEW

- Administration: The GroupWise Administrator snap-in for NetWare® Administrator includes new functionality to support updates to the other components. A new component, the GroupWise Administrator snap-in for ConsoleOne™, lets you use ConsoleOne to create, delete, and manage domains, post offices, GroupWise user accounts, resources, distribution lists, and agents.
- Agents: Updates include the ability to run the Windows NT* agents as NT services, run the NetWare NLM™ agents in protected mode on NetWare 5, and monitor the agents from a web browser. Many of the GroupWise client enhancements, such as improved Remote performance and access to POP3, IMAP4, and LDAP Internet accounts, require the new agents.
- Client: Updates to the GroupWise client for Windows* 95/98/NT (32-bit) include access to POP3, IMAP4, and LDAP Internet accounts, enhanced S/MIME security features, ability to compose messages in HTML, improved Remote performance, ability to send GroupWise e-mail from a web browser, implementation of Routing Slip, auto-update through TCP/IP, and support for Novell® Single Sign-on.
- WebAccess: Updates include a redesigned user interface with added functionality, the use of Java* servlets on the web server rather than CGI Extensions, simplified installation and configuration, an improved administration interface in NetWare Administrator, and the ability to monitor the WebAccess Agent from a web browser.
- Internet Agent: Updates include a browser-based interface, paging capabilities, and flat forwarding.
- Monitor: This completely new Java version includes a browser-based interface, a separate server component, customizable poll schedules and thresholds for increased administrator control, and integration with NDS™.

GROUPWISE 5.5 ENHANCEMENT PACK**INSTALLATION**

Before installing an Enhancement Pack component, you should read the component's Quick Start card, accessible through the Enhancement Pack installation program. The card provides overview information, system requirements, and installation instructions, as well as dependencies on other Enhancement Pack components.

Although it is not required, we recommend that you install the administration and agent components before installing the client, WebAccess, Internet Agent, or Monitor components.

To view the Quick Start cards or install a component,

1. At a Windows 95/98/NT workstation, insert the GroupWise 5.5 Enhancement Pack CD.
2. If the installation program does not start automatically, run SETUP.EXE from the root of the CD.
3. Click Install Products to display the list of Enhancement Pack components.

GroupWise Administration: Extends the tree's NDS schema, updates GroupWise Administrator for NetWare Administrator, and installs GroupWise Administrator for ConsoleOne. You are also given the option to copy the agent, client, WebAccess, Internet Agent, and Monitor software to the software distribution directory. You can then install these components from the software distribution directory or use the options listed below to install them from the CD.

GroupWise Agents: Installs or updates the agent software on a network server.

GroupWise Client: Installs the GroupWise client for Windows 95/98/NT to a workstation.

GroupWise WebAccess: Installs or updates a GroupWise WebAccess installation.

GroupWise Internet Agent: Installs or updates a GroupWise Internet Agent installation.

GroupWise Monitor: Installs GroupWise Monitor.

ConsoleOne: Installs ConsoleOne, version 1.2, which must be installed before you can use GroupWise Administrator for ConsoleOne or GroupWise Monitor

4. Click the component you want to install.
5. View the component's Quick Start card for installation instructions.
6. Install the component.
