

Installing Netscape FastTrack Server for NetWare

When you install the Netscape® FastTrack Server™ for NetWare®, two servers are installed: the administration server, used to manage and configure servers; and the Web server, used to deliver Web pages to the Internet or an intranet.

PREREQUISITES

- Have NetWare 4.11™ or later installed on the server
- Have the latest version of the Novell® Client™ for Windows* 95* or Windows NT* installed on a workstation
- Have an installed Internet browser (Netscape Communicator* 4.04 recommended)
- Have long.nam installed on NetWare servers for long file names
- Connect to a NetWare 4™ network

SERVER HARDWARE REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 100 MB free disk space on SYS volume
- Minimum 32 MB RAM (64 MB RAM recommended)

CLIENT HARDWARE REQUIREMENTS

- 486 processor or better
- Minimum 100 MB free disk space
- Minimum 64 MB RAM

SOFTWARE INCOMPATIBILITIES

Novell cannot guarantee that the FastTrack Server for NetWare will work with the following software:

- Microsoft* Client for NetWare networks
- Microsoft file and printer sharing for NetWare networks
- Microsoft Service for Novell Directory Services®
- Microsoft Internet Explorer

PROCEDURE

1. At the client workstation, insert the FastTrack Server for NetWare CD-ROM and browse for Fasttrac.exe from the root CD drive (for example, d:\Fasttrac\Fasttrac.exe).
2. Follow the on-screen instructions.

Note: Once the FastTrack Server for NetWare is successfully installed, you can begin using the server by accepting all of its default settings.

Otherwise, use the administration server to change the default configuration.
