

Installing NetWare for Small Business 4.2

Easy to install and manage, NetWare® for Small Business™ 4.2 is a network software system designed to give single-site businesses superior performance and powerful intranet and Internet capabilities.

PREREQUISITES

- ❑ A basic understanding of networking and NDS™. See Appendix A, “Understanding Networks and NDS” in *Installation and Administration*.

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- ❑ A PC with a 486 (SX or DX), Pentium*, or higher processor
- ❑ A network board
- ❑ A CD-ROM drive that can read ISO 9660 formatted CD-ROM disks
- ❑ 32 MB RAM (48 is recommended)
- ❑ A 1 GB hard disk with a minimum of 100 MB for the DOS partition, and at least 500 MB for the NetWare partition

NEW INSTALLATION

1. Insert the NetWare for Small Business CD and the Pre-Installation/Licensing diskette into the appropriate drives.
2. Reboot the computer and follow the screen prompts to reformat the hard disk, create a new partition, and install this product.

UPGRADE FROM NETWARE FOR SMALL BUSINESS 4.11, INTRANETWARE FOR SMALL BUSINESS, NETWARE 3™, OR NETWARE 4™

1. Insert the NetWare for Small Business CD-ROM into the file server’s CD-ROM drive.
2. At the CD-ROM drive prompt, enter INSTALL.
3. Follow the on-screen prompts.

UPGRADE FROM NETWARE 2, PERSONAL NETWARE™, OR OTHER NETWORK OPERATING SYSTEMS

SET UP THE ADMINISTRATOR’S WORKSTATION

1. Boot the Windows* 95/98 workstation, then insert the Novell® Client™ CD into the CD-ROM drive.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts.
